

2020 Safeway Open Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes

- 5** Jordan Spieth has five top-two finishes when making tournament debut on the PGA TOUR with one win (*2017 Travelers Championship*)
- 10.4%** Brandt Snedeker has made 98.8% of his putts from inside six feet at Silverado Resort & Spa North in his last 166 attempts (164 of 166 attempts) compared to just 88.4% in his first 69 attempts (61 of 69).
- 1st** Led the PGA TOUR in Driving Accuracy percentage last season, hitting 74.50% of his fairways. It's the first time Furyk has finished First in a season and the 16th time Furyk has ranked inside the top 10 in Driving Accuracy in a season (only Fred Funk have more seasons in last 40 years).
- 37' 5"** Led the PGA TOUR last season in Rough Proximity, averaging 37' 5" to the hole on approach shots from the Rough. Perez averaged 6' 8" closer than the TOUR average (44' 1").
- 127** Keegan Bradley has played his last 127 consecutive holes without a three-putt, marking the ninth longest current streak of any player on TOUR.
- 32nd** Finished 32nd in the FedExCup last season, marking his third best FedExCup finish of his PGA TOUR career. Strelman is the highest ranked player in the FedExCup from last season
- 9** Phil Mickelson is one of nine players who have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in all 14 seasons.
- 14** Phil Mickelson is tied with Tiger Woods for the most PGA TOUR wins in the state of California of any player (14) in the last 37 years.
- 61.43%** Shane Lowry has the best Sand Save percentage of any player (min 60 rds) in the last two PGA TOUR seasons. Lowry has managed to get up and down from greenside bunkers 61.43% of the time since the start of the 2018-19 season.
- 56** Brendan Steele has the third best cumulative score to par at this event in the FedExCup era. Steele is 56-under par in 32 career rounds at the Safeway Open, only Chez Reavie (-63) and Martin Laird (-57) have a better career score to par at this event.
- 1' 10"** Kevin Tway had the best approach putt performance of any player averaging 1' 10", marking the first player to average closer than 1' 11" in Approach putt performance for a PGA TOUR season in the ShotLink era.
- 60%** For the week, Tway made six of 10 putts from 10-15 feet, including six of eight in the final three rounds en route to victory at the 2018 Safeway Open.
- 93rd** Emiliano Grillo finished 93rd in the FedExCup last season, marking the fifth consecutive season qualifying for the FedExCup Playoffs.
- 5** Sergio Garcia has five top-two finishes including three wins (2005 Kemper, 2002 Sentry TOC & 2001 Charles Schwab Challenge) when making his tournament debut on the PGA TOUR.

FedExCup Storylines & Notes

- 9** Nine of the 11 winners during the fall of the 2019-20 PGA TOUR season qualified for the TOUR Championship.
- 12.8%** Percentage of players to qualify for the TOUR Championship who earned FedExCup points in the fall or season opening events on the PGA TOUR in the last seven seasons (187 of 1,461)
- 4** Since the 2013 Safeway Open, four of the seven winners at this event have qualified for the TOUR Championship.
- 63%** Since the start of the wrap-around schedule (2013-14), 63% of winners in the season opening events (fall) have finished inside the top 30 of the final FedExCup standings. Justin Thomas (2017) and Justin Rose (2018) are the only two players who have won in the Fall portion of the wrap-around schedule and went on to win the FedExCup title that season.

- 52.94%** Silverado Resort and Spa North has the fourth toughest fairways to hit of any course over the last six PGA TOUR seasons (min 15,000 possible Fwys). In this time frame, the field finds the fairway 52.94% of the time.
- +0.95** Since 2014, three of the last six winners at the Safeway Open ranked inside the top-five in Strokes Gained: Off-the-Tee, outperforming the field by an average of +0.95 strokes per round off the tee.
- 5** Since 2014, five of the last six winners at the Safeway Open have ranked inside the top 20 in Greens in Regulation at Silverado Resort and Spa North.
- 65.73%** Last season, the field hit 65.73% of the greens in regulation, marking the lowest Greens in Regulation percentage at Silverado Resort and Spa North in the last six seasons.

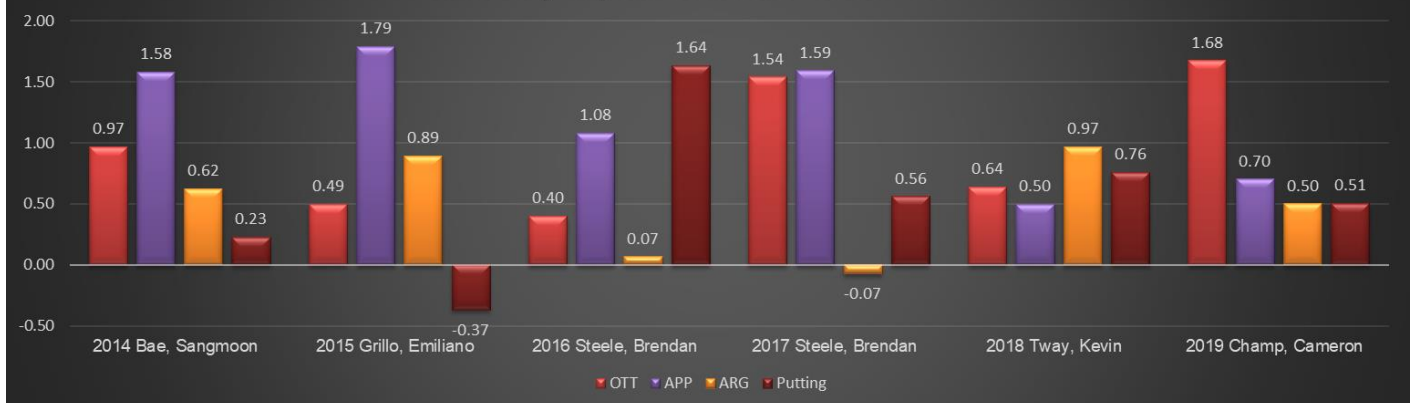

2010 FedExCup champion Jim Furyk is set to make his 626th official start of his PGA TOUR career and second appearance at the Safeway Open (2019/T17).

1st Led the PGA TOUR in Driving Accuracy percentage last season, hitting 74.50% of his fairways. It's the first time Furyk has finished First in a season and the 16th time Furyk has ranked inside the top 10 in Driving Accuracy in a season (only Fred Funk have more seasons in last 40 years).

212 Since 1994, Jim Furyk is one of three players (Phil Mickelson & Tiger Woods) who have 200 or more rounds of 66 or better on TOUR. In this timeframe, Jim Furyk has recorded 212 rounds of 66 or better, third most of any player.
