TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

Back to Japan: The PGA TOUR heads back to Asia for the first time since the 2019 World Golf Championships-HSBC Champions, while the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP returns to Japan after being contested at Sherwood Country Club in California in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP was successfully launched at Accordia Golf Narashino Country Club in 2019 and marked Japan's first official PGA TOUR event.

In 2019, Narashino was the site of Tiger Woods' record-tying 82nd PGA TOUR victory. Woods defended his title at the 2020 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, finishing T72.

Hideki at home: Reigning Masters Tournament champion and Ehime, Japan, native Hideki Matsuyama will make his third start at the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP and second in Japan. The six-time PGA TOUR winner finished runner-up to Tiger Woods at Narashino in 2019 and T28 at Sherwood last year. After winning the Masters, Matsuyama received the Prime Minister's Award in recognition of being the first male Japanese golfer to win a major championship.

Olympic medalists: Xander Schauffele returns to Japan for the first time since defeating Rory Sabbatini of Slovakia by one stroke to win the gold medal at the 2020 Olympic Games (Kasumigaseki Country Club outside of Tokyo). The four-time PGA TOUR winner finished T10 in the 2019 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP and was T17 at Sherwood. Currently No. 5 in the Official World Golf Ranking, Schauffele has ties to Japan as his mother, who hails from Chinese Taipei, grew up in Japan while his grandparents still live in the country. Bronze medalist C.T. Pan is also in the field. Pan, who emerged from a seven-man playoff that included Rory McIlroy, Paul Casey and Matsuyama, is making his second start in the event (T59/2019).

Path to the FedExCup title: Patrick Cantlay won the 2020 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, his first of four victories during the 2020-21 season, and went on to capture the FedExCup title. Cantlay is one of three FedExCup champions in the last five seasons to win a tournament during the fall portion of the season en route to the FedExCup crown, joining Justin Thomas (2017) and Justin Rose (2018).

FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES

Last time out: Rory McIlroy became the 39th player to record 20 victories on the PGA TOUR, winning last week's THE CJ CUP @ SUMMIT by one stroke over Collin Morikawa in his season debut. McIlroy won in his 205th career start at the age of 32 years, 5 months, 13 days, and won in his PGA TOUR season debut for the first time in his career. He led the field in Strokes Gained: Putting for the second time in his career and first since the 2018 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard.

Down the stretch: Through the first four events of the 2021-22 season, no 54-hole leader/co-leader has gone on to win. Only two of the last 21 events on the PGA TOUR have been won by a player who entered the final round with at least a share of the lead (Patrick Cantlay/BMW Championship, TOUR CHAMPIONSHIP).

Rookie watch: Three of the 27 PGA TOUR rookies are in the top 15 in the FedExCup standings after the first four events of the 2021-22 season: (11) Cameron Young, (12) Mito Pereira and (14) Hayden Buckley.

Streaks extended in 2020-21: Dustin Johnson qualified for the TOUR Championship for the 13th consecutive season, the longest streak in the FedExCup era (2007-present). Six other players have active streaks of five years or more: Hideki Matsuyama (8), Patrick Reed (8), Justin Thomas (6), Tony Finau (5), Jon Rahm (5) and Xander Schauffele (5).

Six players have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in each year during the FedExCup era (2007-present): Charley Hoffman (finished 32nd in the FedExCup), Phil Mickelson (70), Bubba Watson (81), Adam Scott (90), Brandt Snedeker (97) and Matt Kuchar (122).

SPONSOR EXEMPTION SPOTLIGHT

Hiroshima native Ryuji Imada will be making his 251st PGA TOUR start and first since the 2015 Barbasol Championship (MC). Imada has 51 career top-25 finishes, highlighted by his lone win at the 2008 AT&T Classic, and last made a cut on TOUR at the 2014 Barracuda Championship (T61). The former University of Georgia golfer first joined the PGA TOUR in 2005.

Imada holds the distinction of being the last player to win on TOUR after losing in a playoff at the same tournament the year before. He lost in a playoff at the 2007 AT&T Classic and won the following year (def. Kenny Perry in a playoff).
