Storytelling Messaging

- 1. We Run for All: John Deere is celebrating its 25th anniversary as title sponsor of the John Deere Classic, placing them second on the list of longest-running title sponsors on the PGA TOUR behind AT&T. Its "We Run for All" tagline is a commitment to touching lives from all different backgrounds and walks of life within the community, with more than 500 local charities benefitting from a record \$14.1 million generated from the 2023 tournament. At the PGA TOUR's 2023 Tournament Meetings, the John Deere Classic was awarded "Most Engaged Community" for the eighth time since 2008, which considers spectator attendance, volunteer support and how well the community is weaved into the overall flavor of the tournament.
- 2. July 4: For the second consecutive year, the John Deere Classic will be held during the July 4 holiday (Thursday). The tournament is going above and beyond to recognize military members on-site (active, retired, vets, and first responders) through private hospitality and Folds of Honor Friday, a new TOUR initiative that awards 13 scholarships in Iowa and Illinois. During Folds of Honor Friday, 99-year-old D-Day paratrooper survivor Henry Langrehr (LANG-er) from Clinton, Iowa will be honored on site.
- 3. **Field:** Highlights include two-time winner **Jordan Spieth**, one of two players with multiple victories in the event since 2000 (Steve Stricker/2009, 2010, 2011). Spieth returns to the John Deere Classic for the first time since 2015 when he won his second of two titles. In 2013, Spieth claimed his first PGA TOUR title as a 19-year-old to become the youngest player to win on TOUR since 1931. Spieth enters the week at No. 59 in the FedExCup with five weeks remaining in the Regular Season.
 - a. Straka in Silvis: Defending champion Sepp Straka captured his second career TOUR title in 2023 following a final-round 62. Straka carded a 1-over 73 to sit T133 after the opening round, the lowest position for a PGA TOUR winner on record since 1983. He was also the first player since 1992 to post an over-par score at the John Deere Classic and go on to win.
 - b. **Day's Back:** 13-time TOUR winner **Jason Day** will make his first start at the John Deere Classic since 2011, where he owns a pair of T15 finishes in five previous appearances at TPC Deere Run, (2009, 2010).
 - c. **Johnson Right at Home:** 2012 winner **Zach Johnson** will make his 22nd career start at the John Deere Classic, four more than any player on TOUR since 2002 (Jonathan Byrd, 18). Including his win, Johnson owns seven career top-five finishes at TPC Deere Run.

- 4. **Golf Course:** An unreasonably warm, late winter coupled with timely spring rainfall has TPC Deere Run growing fervently ahead of the soon-to-be-arriving heat and humidity customary to the Quad Cities area. The primary rough has benefitted from ample early-season moisture and is situated to provide penal playing conditions. Since the 2023 tournament, the fairways on Nos. 1, 6, 11 and 15 were narrowed by 6-8 feet in the landing areas.
- 5. **Open Qualifying Series:** The John Deere Classic is part of The Open Qualifying Series (OQS) where two spots will be available into the 152nd Open at Royal Troon. The top player, not otherwise exempt, who makes the cut at the John Deere Classic will earn an exemption. In the event of a tie for a qualifying place, the player with the higher ranking in the OWGR at the beginning of the week will earn the spot.
